
The first step starts here!





Where we'll stay with a local family and take a glimpse of the local life.



Waking up on the fifth day to the beautiful sound of nature then start trekking one of the best treks in Vietnam!


Navigating through the rice fields, crossing rivers, witnessing the magical waterfalls, visiting rural villages and enjoying the paradise of *Sa Pa*.





Followed by an adventurous boat ride in the afternoon to explore the water caves around, and bicycle rides to get immersed even more. All of that in the eighth day.



POST TRIP EXPERIENCES BOOKNOW

THE GREAT NORTHERN LOOP **ON MOTORBIKES**

The trip will start with an evening departure (8 pm) from Hanoi on a comfortable sleeper bus to Ha Giang, where we'll arrive early morning (3 am) and take a nap in a hostel dorm beds.

On the first day, after breakfast, the journey starts with a 120 km motorbike ride from Ha Giang City to Dong Van, passing through notable landmarks like Quan Ba Heaven Gate and the Fairy Bosom hills. The night is spent in a standard hotel in Dong Van.

The second day includes a visit to Dong Van Old Quarter and the Hmong King's Palace, followed by a ride to the breathtaking Ma Pi Leng Pass. The day concludes with an overnight stay in a local homestay in Du Gia Village, featuring a traditional dinner and cultural exchange.

The final day starts with breakfast and a return ride to Ha Giang City, with a stop at Lung Tam Village, known for traditional Hmong weaving. After exploring, we'll return to Ha Giang City to board the bus back to Hanoi, arriving arriving late at night.
